

Road Craft Training Day

We strongly recommend this one day course for anyone who is not a regular bike rider, even if you are, are you familiar with Thailand's Highway code? The average Thai Drivers mind set? We have a saying on the roads in Thailand, "*Me First, You no hit me*" What do's it mean?

The aim of the course is not to teach our customers to suck eggs; it's to give confidence and knowledge and allow you to do what you came here to do, **Enjoy yourself.**

We run regular training days, normally they are held on the day before the first day of each tour. Please allow 2 extra days to tour if the training day option is taken.

Day 1 Arrival Day Chiang Mai

We'll pick you up at the airport and bring you to our tour hotel in the heart of the city. Depending on your arrival time, you can go sightseeing, shopping or just relaxing by the pool. In the evening we will have dinner in one of the local restaurants. After we visit the famous "night bazaar".

Day 2 Training Day

We pick you up at you hotel and transport you to our base camp, after a 30 min drive approximate 36 kms north of Chiang Mai city.

The training day starts with a cold drink and an introduction to the scooters, a quick safety brief, then we get out on the scooters, first time out, we ride very quiet roads in the local area so you can make friend with your scooter, after about 30 minutes we head off for a ride in the mountains, the Mae SA Valley, better known locally as the Samoeng loop, a distance of approximate 96kms. This day's ride takes in a monkey school, elephant camp and some of the most beautiful scenery in Thailand.

Then it will be time for the first cold beer and we can fire up the B-B-Q, you will stay in one of our 4 comfortable bungalows.

By the end of the training day you will:

Be up to speed on the Thai highway code.

Understand Road and dirt trail conditions in Thailand.

Know the do; and don'ts in traffic.
